This is the latest and largest in the series of provisional atlases of the British fauna and flora published by the Biological Records Centre. The atlas is the culmination of a project started by the British Arachnological Society in 1987 and makes a major, original contribution to knowledge of the distribution, ecology and phenology of British spiders.

An introductory section describes the history and coverage of the Spider Recording Scheme, and covers spider habitats and conservation. Also included is an essay on Hymenoptera and Diptera as natural enemies of British spiders. A full systematic list follows. The bulk of the Atlas comprises the species accounts

and 10-kilometre square distribution maps for each of the 648 British species. Each species account deals with status, distribution, habitat, ecology, threats and conservation management. For most species, a graph of adult activity throughout the year has also been provided. A bibliography and index to species (valid names and synonyms) are included. A4 paperback format in two volumes, totalling x + 406 pages.
